☐ **Editing:** Even (or especially!) children's books need great editing. Be sure to work through automated programs if necessary to clean up the text portion of your manuscript *before* you send it to an editor. You'll save both you *and* the editor time and headaches, and you'll save money.

☐ Editing Checklist (do these *in order* to get the best results):

___ Read your completed manuscript aloud. Record and play it back.

___ Run your completed manuscript through [grammarly.com](https://www.grammarly.com) (free)

___ Run your completed manuscript through [hemingwayapp.com](https://www.hemingwayapp.com) (free)

___ Run your completed manuscript through [autocrit.com](https://www.autocrit.com) or [prowritingaid.com](https://www.prowritingaid.com) (paid).

___ Place your completed manuscript in a Google Doc and invite friends to "Comment" and review it. (free)

___ Begin interviewing editors for your manuscript (paid):

☐ Interior Formatting.

- ___ After editing is finished, complete another outline to designate which text and which illustrations go to each page of the book.
- ___ Left-hand pages are even numbered, right-hand pages are odd numbered.
- ___ Use an appropriate font for your primary (story) text.
- ___ Load text and illustrations to their assigned pages.
- ___ Ensure font size is appropriate for target reader age.
- ___ Ensure visual flow on each page of text.
- ___ Ensure all illustrations fit on pages without pixelation or distortion.
- ___ Number each page. Remember, even are left-side pages, odd are on right.
- ___ Watch video lesson one of this class for a walkthrough.
- ___ When finished, download as Print-Ready PDF, and upload to CreateSpace.
